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Appendix 1 Sharing and viewing of data in the Information Management Service

Sharing of data in the Information management system with a healthcare or social service provider

Information may be disclosed through the Information Management Service as provided in Section 20 of the Act on the Electronic Processing of Client Data in Social and Health Care Services (hereinafter referred to as the Client Data Act, 703/2023), section 74, stipulates. According to the Act, health care patient data may be disclosed from the Information Management System to another health care service provider or to the same service provider's other patient register for the purpose of organizing, producing and implementing the patient's health care services by means of the national information system services referred to in section 66, notwithstanding secrecy provisions. However, patient data may not be disclosed without the patient's consent.

Sharing of data in the Information Management System within EU countries

Patient data summaries compiled into the Information Management System may be disclosed to health care service providers in EU countries via the Kanta Services on the basis of the patient's consent for the purpose of organizing and implementing electronic health care services. (Client Data Act, 703/2023, section 60)

Browsing the data in the Information Management Service via the citizen's My Kanta service

According to section 74 of the Client Data Act, the information in the Information Management System may be disclosed to the client through the citizen's user interface.

According to section 74 of the Client Data Act, the client may be shown or provided information recorded about them in national information systems through the MyKanta service, with the exception of information to which the client is not entitled to have access under section 11(2) of the Act on the Openness of Government Activities or other legislation. In addition, a person may be shown, via the user interface, the disclosure and user log data concerning access or processing of their data, with the exception of the personal details of the recipient of the disclosure. However, the client may be shown the name of a person who has acted on their behalf.

Logging in to MyKanta takes place with the patient's personal banking codes, electronic ID card or mobile certificate on the Kanta website.
